P5 Trip to RSPB Fairburn Ings – 22nd March 2022

As part of our topic work about plants, we will be visiting RSPB Fairburn Ings on Tuesday 22nd March where your child will encounter a mixture of habitats.

The site is carefully managed to keep Fairburn rich in wildlife. We will have the opportunity to identify different types of plants, learn about basic plant structures and explore plants in different habitats such as Wetland areas created by subsidence, wet grassland, reedbed and wet woodland. While other habitats, including dry grassland, deciduous woodland and lagoons, have been restored on the former coal spoil tips.

There is a small £4 charge for the trip which is payable via ParentPay. No extra spending money is necessary.

A packed lunch will be provided for those children who normally have a school dinner, those who bring a packed lunch should do so as usual.

Your child must wear school uniform for this trip as well as wellies, and a weather appropriate waterproof jacket as we will be outdoors for the duration of the day. We will leave school in the morning, returning in time for transport home at the end of the school day.
